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## ***March 17 - Fargo to Minneapolis to Amsterdam***

Depart Fargo and connect with a flight to Amsterdam.

## ***March 18 - Amsterdam to Arusha***

Arrive at Kilimanjaro Airport and be met by a Kibo Safaris driver, your Ker & Downey representative in Tanzania, who will assist in your transfer to Willy's Cottages, about forty-five minutes from Kilimanjaro Airport.

Enjoy Willy's Cottages, located on a private three-acre lot within Arusha. The cottages are a paradise within the busy city of Arusha. The cozy cottages are set amongst green gardens and feel like a home away from home.

## ***March 19 - Arusha to Tarangire National Park***

After breakfast, depart to Tarangire River River Camp situated within the Tarangire eco-system. It is about a two-hour drive on smooth, paved roads from Arusha. The camp is about two miles from the main gate of the park, located in 25,000 hectares of village land including Lake Burunge and Lake Manyara. This permanent luxury tented camp offers a stunning view over the Tarangire River and the park plains; Lake Manyara, the Rift Valley, Ngorongoro highlands, Oldonyo Lengai, and Kilimanjaro can be seen from each tent.

Tarangire River Camp offers eighteen luxury tents complete with en suite bathroom facilities. There is (24hrs-220v) solar powered electricity. Delicious meals are served in the mess tent shaded by a majestic Baobab tree. Apart from game drives in Tarangire Park, you will be offered tribe visits including the Datoga and Maasai who lived in the area. Walks can also be arranged.

### **Overnight at Tarangire River Camp (B,L,D)**

## ***March 20 - Tarangire National Park***

A full day of game drives at Tarangire National Park will not disappoint even the most seasoned visitor to Africa. In addition to the year-round presence of elephants, Tarangire attracts a large number of animals because of the presence of the Tarangire River. Zebra, antelope, gazelle and wildebeest all drink from the waters of the

river while the resident predators hunt animals gathered on the shoreline.

Today you will meet with Dr. Charles and Lara Foley. Charles and Lara Foley have been studying the elephant population of Tarangire National Park in northern Tanzania for over a decade. Tarangire is home to nearly 3,000 elephants and has become one of the best parks in Africa to see large herds of elephants. The Foleys' work on elephants covers a variety of different topics, including demography, behavior, genetics, and conservation. Over the years they have individually recognized and named over 1,000 elephants.

Dr. Foley completed his undergraduate degree in zoology at Oxford University and his Ph.D. at Princeton University on the long-term effects of poaching on elephant social systems. Lara has a Masters degree from the Institute for Geo-Information Science and Earth Observation in the Netherlands. The Tarangire Elephant Project has been featured in several wildlife documentaries, news programs, and popular wildlife magazines including *BBC Wildlife* and *Wildlife Conservation*. The Foleys appear as their schedule allows.

#### **Overnight at Tarangire River Camp (B,L,D)**

#### ***March 21 - Tarangire National Park to Lake Manyara National Park***

After breakfast, depart to for Lake Manyara National Park. Lake Manyara National Park covers an area of 1,000 square miles, its terrain is so diverse that its mammal and bird lists are some of the most impressive in Tanzania. The park includes not only a substantial portion of the lake and its shores but also large areas of ground-water forest with giant fig and mahogany trees alternating with acacia woodland and open swamplands.

Wildlife seen in the park include: monkey, jackal, mongoose, hyena, hyrax, zebra, hippo, warthog, buffalo, Maasai giraffe, duiker, waterbuck and impala. Significant numbers of elephant are also resident in the park and there are even cases of tree climbing lions. Lake Manyara is also especially noted for its wealth of bird life, being visited by many thousands of pink lesser flamingos, significant numbers of greater flamingos and a host of other woodland, plains and water birds.

The Lake Manyara Serena sits on the edge of the Mto Wa Mbu escarpment and overlooks the glistening waters of Lake Manyara. Optional activities available include walking safaris, mountain bike and canoe safaris, mountain climbing, nature walks and traditional dance performances in the evenings.

#### **Overnight at Lake Manyara Serena (B,L,D)**

***March 22 - Lake Manyara National Park to Ngorongoro Conservation Area***

Today you will transfer to the Ngorongoro Crater, a forty-five minute drive from the Lake Manyara Serena. Upon arrival at the Crater gate you will have the opportunity to visit the Ngorongoro Crater Museum. Maps and a scaled model of the crater chronicle the formation of the crater and the wildlife that lives in it.

Depart the museum for accommodations at the Ngorongoro Serena Lodge. The lodge is built into the rim of the Ngorongoro Crater and its stonework easily blends into the surrounding bush and woodland. Most of the rooms have terraces overlooking the enormous crater. Maasai dancing and other cultural activities are some of the typical events at the lodge.

**Overnight at Ngorongoro Serena (B,L,D)**

***March 23 - Ngorongoro Conservation Area***

Today enjoy a full day of game drives in the Ngorongoro Crater, the heart of the 3,200 square mile Ngorongoro Conservation Area, provide an excellent opportunity to view black rhino and black-maned lion. The enormous crater functions as an ecosystem unto itself. High escarpments, defining the border of the crater, and plentiful water liberate the over 25,000 wildebeest and zebra from the migration that their cousins from the Serengeti endure.

**Overnight at Ngorongoro Serena (B,L,D)**

***March 24 - Ngorongoro Conservation Area to Serengeti National Park***

In the morning drive towards the Serengeti and visit Olduvai Gorge en route. Within the strata of the gorge the Leakey family has found hominid fossils believed to be 1.7 million years old. There is a small museum that chronicles the geological, archaeological and modern histories of the gorge.

The wide, grassy plains signal the arrival in the Serengeti. Covering over 5,700 square miles, the park hosts the majority of one of the world's last great migratory events, the wildebeest migration. Spacious plains, savannas with acacia trees sprouting intermittently from the earth, monolithic kopjes that serve as granite oases and somber woodlands make up the massive tracts of land within the Serengeti's borders. On average the weather in the southern Serengeti during March is dry and comfortable. (60-85 degrees Fahrenheit)

Ndutu Lodge is located in the Southern Serengeti and provides a great chance to get close to the beauty and serenity of the African wilderness. The rooms are located in thatched chalets that located on either side of the unique dining/lounge/bar area. The lounge is decorated in unique cave artistry and horns from various indigenous species. Especially interesting is a cast of an ancient buffalo given to the first owner of Ndutu by Mary Leakey.

**Overnight at Ndutu Lodge (B,L,D)**

***March 25 - Serengeti National Park***

Enjoy a full day of game drives from Ndutu. At this time of the year the migration is not only around this area but the wildebeest should also be calving. The predators are well aware of the abundance of prey and this makes for an exciting safari. Lion, cheetah, hyena and with luck, wild dog should be seen. Wildebeest, zebra, buffalo, giraffe, elephant, topi, pangolin and a host of other game may be seen. Eagles, vultures, and storks soar overhead while secretary bird and bustard tread the plain below.

**Overnight at Ndutu Lodge (B,L,D)**

***March 26 - Serengeti National Park***

Spend your final day in the Serengeti relaxing at the lodge or on a game drive. While at the lodge you might have the chance to see one of the resident gerenuks, whose long limbs and even longer tail often causes them to be mistaken for cats.

**Overnight at Ndutu Lodge (B,L,D)**

***March 27 - Serengeti National Park to Arusha to Amsterdam***

Enjoy a final game drive through the Serengeti. After breakfast it is about a one-hour flight from the Serengeti to Arusha where you will be transferred to a dayroom at Willy's Cottages or continue on for an optional extension to Rwanda. The flight from Kilimanjaro leaves in the evening.

**Day Room at Willy's Cottages (B,L,D)**

***March 28 - Amsterdam to Minneapolis to Fargo***

Arrive in Amsterdam and transfer to your flight to Fargo. Welcome home!

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## March 27 - Arusha to Zanzibar

Arrive in Arusha from the Serengeti. At the Arusha Airport you will board a flight to Zanzibar. Upon arrival you will be met and transferred to the Blue Bay Hotel. You can choose to relax at the resort, or explore the offerings from ancient Stone Town to the perfect white sand beaches of this diverse island on day trips.

Located on the northeast coast of Zanzibar in the Kiwengwa area, famous for its white sand beaches and turquoise ocean, the Blue Bay Hotel offers an idyllic setting for soaking up the sun, safe swimming in a temperate ocean, or visiting the cultural aspects of this unique area. The bungalow rooms feature stunning views over tropical gardens to the azure Indian Ocean.

The rooms have been developed using local design techniques and makuti, which blend into the landscape. The Zanzibar experience is carried through to the tastefully decorated interiors with traditional four-post beds. Modern conveniences include satellite TV, mini bars, air-conditioning, and hair dryers in the bathrooms.

**Overnight at Blue Bay Hotel (B, L, D)**

## March 28 - Zanzibar

In the morning you will enjoy a dolphin experience while sailing on Menai Bay. The bay is nestled on the southern tip of Zanzibar and offers beautiful coastal views. Bottlenose and humpback dolphins are regularly seen and come up close to the boat. In the past decade, tourism has largely replaced dolphin hunting in the area. This trend has resulted in higher dolphin populations and greater tourism revenues for local vendors. Enjoy a traditional Zanzibar lunch overlooking the sea. In the afternoon there is an opportunity to go snorkeling in the azure waters.

Experience some of the ancient traditions of Zanzibar on a cultural tour of Nungwi village. For more than a thousand years, wooden dhows (boats) have been constructed using the same methods and raw materials. This tour includes a visit to Mkokotoni where you can see these techniques still in use today. Also included is a visit to Fukuchani Portuguese ruins, a local fishing village. Get a sampling of local everyday life and visit traditional blacksmiths. There will be free time to visit the beautiful white-sand beaches of the area.

## March 29 - Zanzibar



Zanzibar Spices

Since the abolition of the slave trade, spices have been at the heart of Zanzibar enterprise. Visit a variety of spice farms that offer the chance to smell, taste, and feel this important part of Zanzibar culture. There is the opportunity to purchase all sorts of spices, straight from the source. The rest of the day is at your leisure to enjoy Zanzibar.

**Overnight at Blue Bay Hotel (B, L, D)**

## March 30 - Zanzibar

Transfer to Stone Town, where your experienced guide will show you the historic sites of this old city. The tour is flexible, and can include visits to the Town Market, Slave Market, National Museum, High Court, Slave Chambers, Old German Consulate, Tip-Top House, House of Wonders, Old Fort, the Sultan's Palace, and the Livingstone House.

Board the *Sabran Jamiil Dhow* in the late afternoon. The *Sabran Jamiil* is a large sailing vessel built and decorated in the traditional Arabian theme. Relax on large Persian-style cushions. You will be welcomed aboard with juicy halwa, tender dates, and locally brewed spiced coffee. View Stone Town from a different perspective and imagine what early sailors felt when they approached Zanzibar under the serenity of sails and gentle breezes. Sail past the Africa House, the Old Fort, House of Wonders, Forodhani Gardens, and the Palace Museum. Enjoy the open bar featuring cold soft drinks, beer, wine, and local snacks. As dusk closes in, return under the light of storm lanterns, stars, and the moon.

Tonight there is a very special dinner on the rooftop of Emerson and Green Hotel. An integral part of the skyline of Zanzibar, along with mosque minarets, Hindu temple towers, and church spires, is the Tower Top restaurant of Emerson and Green Hotel. Featuring a panoramic view of Stone Town and a spectacular view of the Indian Ocean, it is the perfect way to watch the sun set. Eighty feet above the Stone Town and sitting on Persian carpets, guests say that dinner here

feels like a ride on a magic carpet. The dining room is open on all sides and guests sit Arabian-style on pillows and carpets, their shoes left at the door, while their dinner is served in five or more courses and accompanied by the sights and sounds of exotic Zanzibar.

**Overnight at Blue Bay Hotel (B, D)**

**March 31 - Zanzibar to Dar es Salaam**

You will be met and transferred to the Zanzibar Airport for the short flight to Dar es Salaam. Upon arrival in Dar es Salaam you will be met and transferred to the Holiday Inn for a day room. Rest and relax before your late evening flight to Amsterdam.

## General Information, Terms and Conditions, Responsibility For Group Departures to Africa

These terms and conditions govern the relationship between Travel Marketing Services, Inc. d/b/a Ker & Downey of Houston (Katy), Texas (herein after referred to as KDH) and you, the purchaser and/or traveler, and they apply to the tours and/or safaris as specially prepared for you. No alterations to these terms and conditions shall be made by any KDH employee, representative or agent, unless in writing by an officer of KDH. An authorized officer of KDH, and no one else shall make all decisions and matters subject to KDH discretion.

**Payments and Documentation.** An advance payment of \$750 per person is required to make reservations more than 90 days prior to departure. (Certain suppliers may require higher amounts, which difference will be advised at the time of inquiry.) Final payment is due 90 days prior to departure. Documents are sent approximately 4 weeks prior to departure. **Late Bookings.** Late bookings will be accepted subject to availability, however full payment will be due upon booking. The airfares used to create the tour prices are based on group rates that have advance purchase requirements. Late bookings may be subject to higher airfares.

**Participation.** Persons not fit for long trips due to physical conditions such as, but not limited to heart disease, chronic illness, physical handicap, advanced pregnancy, and/or mental illness should not participate in KDH travel programs. Pricing. KDH reserves the right to alter and adjust upwards prices quoted should inflation, costs of fuel, labor or material, airfares, and/ or foreign exchange rates impact initial pricing.

**Not Included in Tour and/or Safari Costs.** Fees for obtaining passports or visas, inoculations, excess baggage charges, insurances of any kind, airport departure taxes not included in the airline ticket price, taxes or service charges approved after the date of our original invoice, optional touring, any items of a personal nature, such as communications charges, room service, purchases or gratuities, excess mileage carried out at the request of the passenger, items not expressly identified as included and transportation not specifically listed as included in tour and/or safari costs. Beverages (liquor and soft drinks) and laundry are included at select properties and this will be expressly specified in the itinerary inclusions.

**Alterations to Tours.** KDH reserves the right to alter or modify the itinerary of any tour and/or safari, if air schedule or surface transportation charges, security matters, and/or events beyond its control make such alterations necessary at the sole and absolute discretion of KDH.

**Cancellation.** Cancellation penalties imposed on KDH by its suppliers are extremely stringent. The following terms apply effective as of the date KDH receives written notice of cancellation from the purchaser and/or traveler.

- 91 days or more prior to departure – \$250.00 per person
- 90 - 46 days prior to departure date – 20% of the total tour cost
- 45 - 15 days prior to departure date – 65% of total tour cost
- 14 days or less, prior to departure date – 100% of tour cost to include handling fee and liquidated damages for KDH.

**No Refund of Unused Arrangements.** As KDH prices are based on contract rates, if you cancel while the tour and/or safari is in progress, there will not be any refund for the unused portion.

**Airfares & Schedules.** The cost of the tour and/or safari may include air transportation as required in the itinerary either from/to the USA gateway or for a portion of the itinerary. Tour prices are based on special airfares that do carry change and cancellation penalties. In certain instances airfare is non-refundable. Please be sure you understand these charges before accepting the itinerary. KDH will not assume any responsibility for any air schedule changes; however, we will attempt to keep you fully informed of changes as we learn of them.

We do not arrange for loyalty program / mileage free tickets or upgrades, but we will be pleased to provide you with a detailed flight itinerary required for any of these programs.

KDH cannot offer travel insurance to non-USA & non-Canadian residents, however, the purchase of third party cancellation insurance is recommended.

**Single Room Policy and Shared Rooms for Single Travelers.** Due to periodic shortages of accommodations on safari, a single room is not guaranteed, even if paid for in advance. If single accommodations are not provided, an appropriate refund will be made upon your return.

**Baggage.** The scheduled IATA airlines permit economy class passengers to carry 2 average sized suitcases for which specific measurements and weight are written in their tariffs. Carriers have specific tariffs that apply to carry-on baggage as well. One average sized suitcase will be carried on safari, however, clients who will be traveling by light aircraft must carry medium sized soft luggage or duffel bags when flying sectors in small light aircraft which have limited space for baggage and weight restrictions. City hotels do store luggage for guests while they are out on safari.

**Health Requirements.** KDH endeavors to provide the latest information about the mandatory health requirements for our destinations but does not assume responsibility for the accuracy of this information. Yellow fever, malaria, typhoid fever, and polio are among the diseases endemic to many regions of the world, and precautions must be taken. Most travelers update tetanus, diphtheria, hepatitis A & B inoculations. Travelers are expected to see their health practitioner for advice. Required inoculations, if any, must be recorded by the traveler's health practitioner on a valid vaccination certificate, which the traveler must carry for proof of inoculation where required. If a potential traveler is concerned about any medications and/or inoculations, it is strongly recommended that each traveler check with their respective health practitioner BEFORE booking.

**KDH Responsibility.** KDH solely acts as a booking agent for hotels, airlines, air charters, bus companies, ground transportation, boat purveyors or owners, and other independent contractors providing accommodations, transportation, and/or other services abroad. Each of these companies is an independent corporation with its own management, and is not subject to the control of KDH, including, but not limited to, Ker Downey Botswana (PTY) Ltd., and various other overseas operators.

All bookings like those described above are accepted by KDH, solely as agent for independent overseas ground operators. The transportation, accommodations and other services provided by the ground operators offered are subject to the terms and conditions contained in the tickets, exchange orders or vouchers issued by them and/or their suppliers. Because KDH does not have the right to control the operations of the independent operators and their suppliers, KDH CANNOT BE LIABLE FOR ANY PERSONAL INJURY OR PROPERTY DAMAGE which may arise out of these services.

KDH reserves the right to cancel any itinerary or any part of it, to make such alterations in the itinerary as it deems necessary or desirable, to refuse to accept or to retain as a member of any program any person at any time, and to pass on to program members any expenditure occasioned by delays or events beyond its control. In case of any appreciable variation in its cost, KDH reserves the right to adjust its rates upwards.

Risks. KDH draws your attention to the fact that there are certain inherent risks involved in participating in the type of adventure trips sold by KDH, and that you accept them at your own risk.

It is your sole responsibility to take all appropriate medical advice prior to departure as to whether or not you are fit enough to undertake the trip booked. KDH shall not be liable for illness, injury or death sustained on a program sold by KDH, which is not due to the gross negligence of KDH, its officers, employees, authorized representatives or agents whomsoever.

Force Majeure. "Force Majeure" means, in relation to KDH, any circumstances beyond the reasonable control of KDH (including, but without limitation, acts of God, explosion, flood, tempest, fire or accident, war or threat of war, sabotage, terrorism, insurrection, civil disturbance, or requisition, sickness, quarantine, government intervention, weather conditions or other untoward occurrences).

If KDH is affected by a Force Majeure it shall forthwith notify you of the nature and extent thereof. KDH shall not be deemed to be in breach of these terms and conditions or otherwise be liable to you, by reason of delay in performance, or by nonperformance, of any of its obligations hereunder to the extent that any such delay or nonperformance is due to any Force Majeure.

If KDH is affected by a Force Majeure it reserves the right to, and may in its sole and absolute discretion, vary or cancel any itinerary or arrangement in relation to the trip. Payment of any refund by KDH to you as a result of the nonperformance of any of KDH's obligations hereunder, shall remain in its sole and absolute discretion, although KDH shall use its reasonable endeavors to reimburse you where possible. However, KDH shall be entitled to deduct from any refund recoverable the reasonable, actual, and potential costs to KDH of the Force Majeure.

Regarding civil unrest, once KDH has investigated the prevailing situation, as it deems fit, it shall remain in KDH's sole and absolute discretion whether to proceed with the trip. You may in such circumstances cancel the trip. However, if, after having made all reasonable and proper inquiries, KDH is of the opinion that the trip may proceed in its sole and absolute discretion, no refund will be payable to you, and the provisions stated under Cancellations shall apply.

Insurance. KDH strongly recommends that you obtain the following types of insurance, which are offered by KDH and are also commercially available by third party insurers: Sickness and medical expense, Accidental death and disability, Major Medical, Emergency medical evacuation, Loss of personal effects, Trip cancellation/interruption, Trip cost default protection, and Trip delay

Consent. The advance payment OR any other partial payment for a reservation on a tour and/or safari constitutes consent to all provisions of the conditions and general information contained in this agreement. The terms under which you agree to take these tours and/or safaris cannot be changed or amended except in writing signed by an authorized officer of KDH. Airlines. The passenger contract in use by each carrier concerned, when issued, shall constitute the sole contract between the transportation companies and the purchaser of this tour and/or travelers.
